About the database:

Taylor & Francis Online is a multidisciplinary online content platform created in collaboration with researchers, scholarly societies, universities and libraries that gives full text online access to 2022 journal titles published by two leading academic publishers - Taylor & Francis (science, technology & engineering) and Routledge (social science, arts, humanities, behavioural science). Also includes some encyclopedias and indexing databases,

What does it cover:

Includes quality peer reviewed content from a wide range of scholarly journals and reference sources in all DUT academic subjects including: accounting, arts, behavioural sciences, bioscience, built environment, business management, communication studies, computer science, development studies, earth sciences, economics, education, engineering, environment, finance, food science & technology, geography, health & social care, humanities, information science, language & literature, law, mathematics & statistics, medicine - dentistry - nursing and allied health, physical sciences, politics & international relations, social sciences, sport and leisure, technology, tourism (and ecotourism), urban studies - as well as area studies including 49 African studies.

How do I access the database:

Go to the Database list under QuickLinks on the Library website: <http://library.dut.ac.za> and find Taylor & Francis Online or, go to the URL <http://www.tandfonline.com>. To access some full text content from off-campus you will be asked to login. Follow the instructions on the login screen.

Special Features:

- Each journal title has its own home page that includes: aims and scope, publication history, information for authors, subscription information and news.
- Browse the contents, view all the available issues, look at the current or latest issues, look at the most read and the most cited articles in each journal.
- Taylor & Francis group publishes a range of peer reviewed and expedited online Open Access journals and full text of these is also available here - including those produced under the Creative Commons Attribution License. The website gives guidance on how to publish in these Open Access journals.
- Simple or Advanced searching can be done within a single journal title or across the entire database. Find related articles. Taylor & Francis Online also provides a citation search.
- Choose your journal title and click - Alert me - to be kept informed of new issues when they are published and become available online.
- Presents regular and topical 'themed article collections' which it makes available free to read online.
- Has a wide range of clear user guides and online tutorials (see the Resources page under Training and choose what you want help with - such as Search)
